What We Do:

- The Department of ESOL offers remedial English courses for Ivy Tech students who are not yet ready for college-level English.
- The ESOL Open Lab (established in Spring 2016) offers drop-in tutoring services to non-native speakers of English of all levels, not just those in ESOL prefixed courses.
- Students can come in for help and guidance on their classwork or to improve their English proficiency in listening, speaking, reading, and writing.
