






Jan. – Sept. 2017, n=674 Gonorrhea Age Breakdown By Percentage




Jan. – Sept. 2017 Gonorrhea Race Breakdown, n=674


Percentage of Gonorrhea Cases by Race



Allen County Census Race Data & Racial Distribution of GC Cases Jan.-Sept. 2017




Jan. – Sept. 2017, n=1,657 Chlamydia Age Breakdown By Percentage




Jan. – Sept. 2017 Chlamydia Race Breakdown, n=1,657

Allen County Census Race Data & Racial Distribution of CT Cases Jan.-Sept. 2017




