Engaging Childcares to Impact Infant Mortality Project Overview

- Focuses on decreasing the amount of safe sleep deaths in areas with highest needs in Allen County
 - Provides safe sleep materials to Providers
 - Increases # of infant slots available
 - Helps Providers increase Paths to QUALITY levels
 - Trains Providers to become Safe Sleep Ambassadors

Safe Sleep Environments

 Gives the Childcare Provider overview of Project

 Assesses Provider's current sleep environment

 Discusses materials needed for a safer slee environment

Orders materials to deliver to the Provide

• Supports Provider in setting up the Safe Sleeping environment

• Follows-up with Provider to ensure Safe Sleeping practices continue to be met



Safe Sleep Ambassadors and Conversation Tools

- Providers can advocate for Safe Sleep by becoming an Ambassador
 - Providers take Cribs for Kids Safe Sleep training
 - Reviews Childcare Parent Survey with Provider and materials in Family Engagement packet (shown right)
 - Provider receives certificate of completion
- Community Sleep Safely flyer



Making an Impact

- Supports Family Childcare Providers through a Learning Community which allows for:
 - Infrastructure growth
 - Professional development
 - Collaboration with other Childcare Providers
 - Business goal setting
 - Connections to other early childhood systems
 - Child Development Associate (CDA) certification
